

## **LOCATION**



## By car

Follow the motorway E40 that becomes the N23 when entering the city. At the Schuman roundabout, take the second exit, which leads onto Rue de la Loi. Follow Rue de la Loi until Rue de la Science. Turn left onto Rue de la Science. Cross Rue Belliard. Turn then right onto Rue Montoyer. The Representation of the State of Hessen to the EU is on the left hand side.

Limited short-term public parking space is available in Rue de l'Industrie and around Square Meeûs. The nearest public underground car park ("Interparking") is located in 19, Rue de la Loi, 1040 Brussel.

# By public transport

From Brussels Airport (BRU): Proceed to platform C at Level 0. Take Bus no. 12 or 21 to "Brussels-Luxembourg". Alight at station "Brussels-Luxembourg". Cross Square Luxembourg towards Rue du Luxembourg. Follow Rue du Luxembourg, then turn right onto the Rue de l'Industrie. The Represention of the State of Hessen to the EU is on the left hand side.

From Gare du Midi (Railway station): Take Metro no. 2 or 6 to "Elisabeth". Alight at station "Trône/Troon". Leave the station through the exit "Rue Montoyer". Walk down Rue Montoyer. The Representation of the State of Hessen to the EU is on the right hand side.

# **RESOURCE EFFICIENCY AS A TOPIC OF ERDF-FUNDING**

BEST PRACTICES 2014-2020, IDEAS FOR 2021-2027

Efficient management of limited resources is an ecological and economic necessity. The subject of resource efficiency is not only about the optimised use of raw materials and protection of the environment. Above all, it is a question of safeguarding the competitiveness of local industry. Resource efficiency and environmental technologies are thus among the priorities of the technology promotion policies in Hessen and many other EU regions.

The workshop will focus on the lessons learned from delivering ERDF-funded resource efficiency support programmes in Denmark, Estonia, France and Germany. Policy officers from regional governments are invited to exchange knowledge and experiences on implementing programmes related to resource efficiency and to develop and discuss possible funding schemes for 2021-2027.

The event will be co-hosted by the Representation of the State of Hessen to the European Union and co-organised by the economic development agency Hessen Trade & Invest (HTAI). It will be held in English (with no translation).
